Copy of Rules and Regulations:

MEMBERSHIP. The membership is open to all those who are of the trip of inspirity agree to obide by the Rules & Regulations of the Society and wish to serve for Chantable causes for the welfare of mankind withour any personal gain or motive.

The person described to become the member of the Society shall apply an presented forms. The application shall be considered and scrutinised by the Governing Body who may except or reject the same and the decision of the Governing Body shall be final. On domestich, every member shall sign the "Register of Members" maintained by the Society.

- SUBSCRIPTION I were member shall pay monthly or yourly subscription as presented by the Governing Budy from time to time and shall deposit the same with the Cashier who will issue a proper receipt of the same.
- 3 GOVERNING BODY (Formation and Functions)
 i) The allians of the Society shall be managed by the body known as "Governing Body" Which shall consist of at-least worm members The list of present Governing Body is fully detailed in Para No. 4 of the Memorandum of Association.
 - Thermembers to the Governing Body shall be elected from amongst the members by majority of votes by the General Body once in a year.
 - The names, addresses and occupation of the members so elected to the Governing Body shall be communicated to Registrar of Societies within two weeks of its formation.
 - The Governing Body shall not stand dissolved merely on account that any of its members has resigned or otherwise left the Association, but the remaining members of the Governing Body shall have the power to nominate any member in his place till the next general election.

- 14. INVESTMENT OF FUNDS OF THE SOCIETY/TRUST The hands of the land. Society shall be invested in the modes specified under the provisions of Section 13 (I) (d) read with Section 11 (5) of the Income Tax Act, 1961 as amended from time to time. It is hereby clarified that all the members of the Trust/Society are rendering social and honorary services and have no personal interest.
- 15 BENEFICIERIES OF THE TRUST/SOCIETY : The benefits of the Trust/society shall be opened to all mankind irrespective of Caste, Cread or Religion
- 16. UTILISATION OF INCOME: It is specifically provided that all the members of the Trust/Society including the members in the Managing Committee shall be rendering Honorary Services to the Trust/Society. No portion of the Income of the Trust/Society shall be utilised for payment to the members of the Society including members of the Managing Committee by way of any profit, interest, dividend etc. The funds of the Income of the Trust/Society shall solely be utilised for the achievements of the objects of the Trust/Society.
- 17 AMENDMENTS: No amend ment of the memorandum of Association/Bye Laws/ Rules and Regulations shall be made which may prove to be repugnant to the provisions of section 2 (15), 11, 12 and 13 and 80-G of the Income Tax Act, 1961 as amended from time to time. Further no amendment shall be carried out without the prior approval of the Commissioner of Income Tax.
- 18 THE PRESIDENT: The President of the Society shall conduct regulate and preside all the meetings of the Society. His rulings as to point of order shall be final and Conclusive, He shall also be the appointing autority of the employees of the Society.
- 19 THE VICE PRESIDENT: In the absence of the President, the Vice-President shall Preside all the meetings of the Society and excercise all such powers.
